Overview

This demonstrator allows users to assess their company's supply chain resilience through an anonymous self-assessment that evaluates vulnerabilities and capabilities across the supply chain. Users rate their exposure to 24 vulnerability factors (natural disasters, geopolitical disruptions, etc.) and assess 41 resilience capabilities (inventory management, crisis response, etc.) on a 1-7 scale. By comparing vulnerabilities against capabilities, this demonstrator identifies gaps and opportunities to strengthen supply chain preparedness. The assessment is anonymous, privacy-preserving, and provides actionable insights to improve resilience and business continuity.

Opportunities

Evaluate Resilience Gaps

Assess supply chain across multiple vulnerability and capability dimensions to identify critical areas where your company may be exposed to disruption risks.

Make Data-Driven Decisions

Use evidence-based assessment results to justify supply chain improvements, allocate resources effectively, and develop targeted resilience strategies.

How It Works

Step 1 - Enter Company Information by providing company name, sector, size, and country.

Step 2 - Load Sample Data. Start with pre-loaded sample scenarios to explore the questionnaire and understand assessment results. This step is optional.

Step 3 - Rate Vulnerabilities. Assess your exposure to 24 supply chain risks on a 1-7 scale (1 = Very Low Risk, 7 = Critical Risk).

Step 4 - Rate Capabilities. Evaluate your company resilience capabilities across 21 dimensions on a 1-7 scale (1 = Not Very Capable, 7 = Strong Capability).

Step 5 - Review Results. View the resilience profile, identify vulnerability-capability gaps, and read AI-enabled assessment report.

Step 6 - Download your assessment report as JSON or PDF for future reference.
